"This vital information is accessed by over 4 million users annually and is the go-to resource for precise marine-related information."

People use the site to find information on tides, weather, and local services. Businesses use the site to promote their products and services to locals and visitors. The new Business Membership program will allow businesses to reach more users, increasing visibility for their services, and boosting their brand awareness among people that use the coast.

US Harbors plans to launch the beta version of the new site in early April and welcomes participation in their user advisory group. All the tide and weather features users currently appreciate will remain the same, but will be delivered with an improved user experience, less advertising, and new features such as local events listings, product reviews, and special boating and fishing content, that enriches the overall experience.
